

DEANS' TEAM AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE NOMINATION CALL AND INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the **Deans' Team Award for Excellence** is to acknowledge outstanding group effort and contribution to advancing our mission. The team's collaborative effort and dedication to one of the mission areas is a focused and compelling example that exemplifies and aligns our community with our mission. The team's efforts must clearly contribute to UC Davis Health being a destination of choice to all we serve.

Team Nomination Criteria

- **Education** – provides outstanding learning opportunities
 - team utilizes creative and multidisciplinary teaching styles to provide a dynamic and integrated curriculum to train the next generation of physicians and health researchers
 - team encourages life-long learning through interactive, interdisciplinary, evidenced-based interactions and problem solving
 - team integrates technologies to enhance educational programs and expand teaching setting
 - team work is evident in collaborative teaching styles and team value is transmitted to students
- **Research** – makes high-impact discoveries
 - multi-disciplinary team guides innovative research program(s)
 - team exemplifies and emphasizes multidisciplinary, collaborative team-based approach
 - team environment exemplifies team approach and includes peer mentoring opportunities
 - research team seeks out innovative, interdisciplinary approaches that utilize collaborative-based team models to study issues
- **Clinical Care** – provides high-quality patient-oriented services
 - multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary team offers consistent, culturally competent, compassionate care to all patients
 - interdisciplinary team efforts optimize clinical services through leveraging academic environment and research resources
 - team collaboratively identifies and delivers patient-oriented services that respond to the compelling needs of our community
 - team exemplifies collaborative, innovative multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary approach to complex clinical care issues
- **Community Engagement** – enhances the quality of life of our local and regional communities
 - multidisciplinary and/or interdisciplinary team participates in community organizations and volunteerism
 - team enhances relations with community partners by encouraging involvement and support of health system programs and being present for community as a UC Davis Health team
 - interdisciplinary team promotes community health through advocacy and impact on healthcare public policy
 - innovative teamwork and partnership mark the community outreach efforts of the team and the community shares the success of the work effort and is a collaboratively partner of the team

Eligibility

Each team must include at least one School of Medicine or Betty Irene Moore School of Nursing Academic Federation or Academic Senate faculty member. Up to four awards will be presented for excellence in one the following areas: Education/Teaching, Research, Clinical Care and Community Engagement.

Nomination Procedures and Guidelines
